Becoming Rich Toward God

5 - Day Devotion

Day 1:

Scripture: "Then he said to them, 'Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions." - Luke 12:15

Reflection: How often do you find yourself wanting more possessions?

Application: Take inventory of your belongings today and thank God for what you have.

Prayer: Lord, help me find contentment in You rather than in material things.

Day 2:

Scripture: "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?" - Luke 12:20

Reflection: If today was your last day, what would matter most?

Application: Write down 3 eternal investments you can make with your time or resources.

Prayer: God, give me an eternal perspective as I live each day.

Day 3:

Scripture: "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God." - Luke 12:21

Reflection: In what ways are you currently "rich toward God"?

Application: Do one act of service or generosity for someone else today.

Prayer: Father, show me how to use my resources to bless others and honor You.

Day 4:

Scripture: "Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share." - 1 Timothy 6:18

Reflection: How can you be "rich in good deeds" this week?

Application: Look for an opportunity to anonymously help or encourage someone today.

Prayer: Lord, make me aware of needs around me and prompt me to good deeds.

Day 5:

Scripture: "In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life." - 1 Timothy 6:19

Reflection: What does "life that is truly life" look like to you?

Application: Set one goal to realign your priorities toward eternal things.

Prayer: Jesus, help me invest in what truly matters for eternity.
