From Now Till Eternity Disciples Live Differently

5-Day Devotion

Day 1:

Scripture: "Come out of her, my people, so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues" (Revelation 18:4)

Reflection: How might you be getting caught up in the "system" of the world rather than fully following Christ?

Application: Identify one area where you need to "come out" and surrender more fully to Jesus today.

Prayer: Lord, show me where I've been seduced by the world's ways. Help me break free and follow You alone.

Day 2:

Scripture: "These have one purpose and will give their power and authority to the beast." (Revelation 17:13)

Reflection: In what ways might you be giving your allegiance to things other than Christ?

Application: Choose one area of your life to intentionally submit to God's authority today.

Prayer: Jesus, I surrender my power, position and pursuits to You. Be Lord of every part of my life.

Day 3:

Scripture: "They will wage war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will triumph over them because he is Lord of lords and King of Kings—and with him will be his called, chosen and faithful followers." (Revelation 17:14)

Reflection: Do you see yourself as part of Christ's "called, chosen and faithful followers"?

Application: Stand firm in your identity in Christ today, resisting temptation to compromise.

Prayer: King Jesus, I choose to stand with You today against the ways of this world. Strengthen my faith.

Day 4:

Scripture: "Fallen! Fallen is Babylon the Great!" (Revelation 18:2)

Reflection: Where do you need reminding that evil systems will ultimately fall and Christ will triumph?

Application: Pray for an area where evil seems to be winning, trusting God will bring justice.

Prayer: Lord, when evil seems strong, remind me that You have already declared its defeat. I trust in Your victory.

Day 5:

Scripture: "Come out of her, my people!" (Revelation 18:4)

Reflection: What practical steps can you take to live as an "obedient saint" in today's culture?

Application: Choose one way to actively share Jesus with others this week.

Prayer: Holy Spirit, empower me to live faithfully for You in this world. Use me to draw others to Christ.
