## 5-DAY DEVOTION

### Day 1:

**Scripture:** "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden." - Matthew 5:14

**Reflection:** How brightly is your light shining for Christ in your daily life?

**Application:** Identify one way you can be more intentional about shining Christ's light today.

**Prayer:** Lord, help me to shine your light boldly and not hide it from others.

### Day 2:

**Scripture:** "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."  
- Romans 6:23

**Reflection:** Do you view salvation as something earned or freely given?

**Application:** Share the gospel message with someone using Romans 6:23 as a guide.

**Prayer:** Thank you God for the free gift of salvation through Jesus. Help me share this good news.

### Day 3:

**Scripture:** "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." - Romans 10:9

**Reflection:** Have you fully embraced Jesus as both Savior and Lord of your life?

**Application:** Confess any areas where you haven't fully surrendered to Christ's lordship.

**Prayer:** Jesus, I declare you as Lord. Help me live fully surrendered to you.

### Day 4:

**Scripture:** "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes" - Romans 1:16

**Reflection:** What holds you back from boldly sharing your faith?

**Application:** Practice sharing your testimony with a friend or family member.

**Prayer:** God, give me courage to overcome my fears in sharing the gospel.

### Day 5:

**Scripture:** "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'" - John 7:37-38

**Reflection:** How are you allowing Christ's living water to flow through you to others?

**Application:** Pray for opportunities to offer Christ's living water to someone who is spiritually thirsty.

**Prayer:** Jesus, fill me with your living water so it can overflow to those around me.
