Small Group Study Questions

Opening Question:

If you could instantly become an expert in sharing one piece of information with others, what would it be and why?

General Observation:

What are some reasons people might be hesitant to share important information with others, even if it could be life-changing?

Understanding the Message:

The sermon discussed Jesus' words in Matthew 5:14-16 about being the light of the world. How would you explain what it means to be "the light of the world" in your own words?

The pastor introduced a tool called "One Verse Evangelism" based on Romans 6:23. What are the key components of this verse, and how does it summarize the gospel message?

Personal Application:

The sermon emphasized the importance of leading lost people to Christ. How comfortable do you feel sharing your faith with others? What are some fears or obstacles that might hold you back?

The pastor said, "If God's put that person in your life, you're responsible." How does this statement challenge your perspective on sharing your faith? Are there specific people in your life you feel responsible for reaching?

Action Steps:

This week, practice explaining Romans 6:23 to yourself or a friend using the "One Verse Evangelism" method. How might this tool help you feel more prepared to share your faith?

Choose one person in your life who may not know Christ and commit to praying for an opportunity to have a spiritual conversation with them this week. What steps can you take to initiate that conversation?

Sample Prayer:

Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for the light of your love and truth in our lives. We confess that sometimes we hide that light out of fear or insecurity. Please give us courage and compassion to share the hope we have in You with those around us. Help us to see the people in our lives through Your eyes and to be bold in sharing the good news of Jesus. Guide our conversations and open doors for us to be Your witnesses. In Jesus' name, Amen.
