### Group Study Questions

#### Opening Question:

If you could be part of any unstoppable team or movement in history, what would it be and why?

#### General Observation:

1. What stood out to you most from the sermon about the unstoppable church?
2. How would you summarize the main message of this sermon in one sentence?

#### Understanding the Message:

3. The sermon outlined four characteristics of the unstoppable church. What were they?
4. In Acts 5, how did Peter and the apostles respond when told to stop preaching about Jesus? What does this teach us about obeying God?
5. How did Gamaliel's advice to the Sanhedrin demonstrate the unstoppable nature of God's work through the church?

#### Personal Application:

6. The sermon emphasized that as believers, we are part of God's unstoppable church. How does this truth impact your perspective on challenges you face in your faith?
7. Pastor Shane said, "Worship is not just singing songs and lifting our hands. Ultimate worship is obedience to the King." How can you apply this concept to your daily life?
8. In what areas of your life do you need to be reminded that "Jesus is King and you can't impeach him"?

#### Action Steps:

9. This week, how can you actively participate in being part of the "unstoppable church" in your community?
10. The sermon stressed the importance of sharing the Gospel. Who is one person you can intentionally share the Good News with this week?
