5 – Day Devotion

Day 1:

Scripture: "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of a woman, born under the law" - Galatians 4:4

Reflection: God's timing is perfect. He sent Jesus at just the right moment in history.

Application: Consider how God's timing has been evident in your own life.

Prayer: Lord, help me trust Your perfect timing, even when I don't understand it.

Day 2:

Scripture: "Therefore, keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come." - Matthew 24:42

Reflection: We should live with expectancy and anticipation of Christ's return.

Application: How can you live today as if Jesus might return at any moment?

Prayer: Jesus, increase my longing for Your return. Help me live in readiness.

Day 3:

Scripture: "Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more" - Romans 5:20

Reflection: God's grace is greater than all our sin and failures.

Application: Is there a past failure you need to release to God's grace today?

Prayer: Father, thank You for Your abundant grace that covers all my sins.

Day 4:

Scripture: "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus." - Galatians 3:28

Reflection: In Christ, our identity is not defined by our past or circumstances.

Application: How might you see yourself differently through the lens of your identity in Christ?

Prayer: Lord, help me find my true identity in You alone.

Day 5:

Scripture: "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us" - John 1:14

Reflection: Jesus entered our world to make a way for us to enter God's family.

Application: Take a moment to thank God for adopting you into His family through Christ.

Prayer: Jesus, thank You for leaving heaven to make me part of Your family.
