

The Ladder Of Life

5-Day Devotion

Day 1:

Scripture: "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, 'Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!'" (John 1:29)

Reflection: Are you focused on seeing Jesus in your daily life, or are other things blurring your vision of Him?

Application: Take time today to intentionally "behold" Jesus - read about Him in the Gospels and reflect on His character.

Prayer: Lord, open my eyes to see You more clearly today. Help me focus on You above all else.

Day 2:

Scripture: "Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, 'What are you seeking?'" (John 1:38)

Reflection: What is your deepest motivation for following Jesus?

Application: Examine your heart and ask yourself why you're truly following Christ.

Prayer: Jesus, purify my motives for following You. May I seek You for who You are, not just what You can do for me.

Day 3:

Scripture: "He said to them, 'Come and you will see.' So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day." (John 1:39)

Reflection: Are you spending quality time with Jesus, or just checking boxes?

Application: Set aside extended, uninterrupted time today to be in Jesus' presence through prayer and Scripture.

Prayer: Lord, draw me into deeper relationship with You. May I delight in Your presence.

Day 4:

Scripture: "Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, 'We have found the Messiah.'" (John 1:40-41)

Reflection: Who in your life needs to hear about Jesus from you?

Application: Pray for opportunities to share Christ with someone this week. When the opportunity comes, take it!

Prayer: Holy Spirit, give me boldness to tell others about Jesus. Use me to draw people to You.

Day 5:

Scripture: "Father, make me a crisis man. Bring those I contact to a decision. Let me not be a milepost on a single road; make me a fork, that men must turn one way or another on facing Christ in me." - Jim Elliot

Reflection: Are you living in such a way that others must decide about Jesus when they encounter you?

Application: Ask God to use you as a "fork in the road" for someone's spiritual journey today.

Prayer: Lord, make my life a compelling witness for You. Use me to bring others face to face with the reality of Christ.
