

Jesus Is Worthy Of First Place In Everything

5-Day Devotion

Day 1:

Scripture: "He is also the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that he might come to have first place in everything." - Colossians 1:18

Reflection: What does it mean for Jesus to have first place in everything in your life?

Application: Identify one area where you need to put Jesus first today.

Prayer: Lord, help me to prioritize You above all else in my life.

Day 2:

Scripture: "For this reason, we must pay attention all the more to what we have heard, so that we will not drift away." - Hebrews 2:1

Reflection: How can unknowns in life lead us to drift from God?

Application: Remember God's faithfulness in your past to fuel belief in His present faithfulness.

Prayer: God, anchor me to You during uncertain times.

Day 3:

Scripture: "I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you." - Psalm 119:11

Reflection: How does storing God's Word in our hearts protect us from sin?

Application: Choose a short verse to memorize this week.

Prayer: Father, may Your Word guide my steps and guard my heart.

Day 4:

Scripture: "They exchanged the truth of God for a lie and worshiped and served what has been created instead of the Creator" - Romans 1:25

Reflection: What "idols" in your life compete for your worship?

Application: Examine what you're giving your time, affection, money and effort to.

Prayer: Jesus, reveal any idols in my life and help me worship You alone.

Day 5:

Scripture: "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." - Romans 10:13

Reflection: How does putting Jesus first impact our families and those around us?

Application: Have a conversation with your family about making Jesus first place.

Prayer: Lord, be first place in my life and family so others may see You through us.
